- HiSET or GED Prep is available for all subjects.
- All online courses can award diploma credits upon completion.

LANGUAGE ARTS CENTER LABS M-Th 8:30a-12:30p - Hamilton Room 10

For Adult Basic Education (ABE), High School English Language Arts, HSE Reading & Writing exam preparation.

- Labs are an open environment where students can learn English language arts skills - from non-reader level to competency-based diploma courses.
- ABE program is a literacy program that provides students with essential reading, writing, speaking, listening, critical thinking, and problem-solving skills.
- High school English courses may be taken in self-paced / independent study labs OR in our new Direct Instruction English Fundamentals courses.

LEARNING CENTER M-Th 8:30a-12:30p, Hamilton Room 10

For Adult Secondary Education (ASE), High School Diploma & Enrichment Courses, HSE Math exam preparation.

- Provides direct instruction courses General Basic Math, Algebra, & HSE Math Prep.
- Offers online self-paced independent learning for all high school credit courses.
- Students may enroll in classes required for diploma, enrichment, and/or HSE prep.
- A credentialed teacher and staff are available for all students who need assistance.
- The Learning Center has a 6-hour per week mandatory attendance requirement.

ENGLISH 1A M-Th 9a-12:30p, Hamilton Room 11

Students can earn High School English credits and improve English Language Arts skills in order to pass the HSE English Language Arts Reading & Writing Exams.

- Build on sequential development and integration of communication skills in 4 major areas: Reading, Writing, Speaking, & Listening.
- Strengthen an increasingly advanced understanding of the structure of language and grammar, and use this knowledge to write literary analyses, professional career documents, poetry, advanced essays, and a focused research project.
- Students will read and comprehend a variety of literature, including drama, literary fiction, poetry, and foundational American documents.
- Students earn up to 5 English credits upon successful completion of coursework.

HSE BOOT CAMPS

Designed for students who will be taking an HSE Exam (HISET or GED) in one of the subjects in the near future.

- Take practice tests to determine your readiness for the official exam
- Improve your skills that are necessary for passing the HSE Exams
- Bootcamps are offered every term - more dates will be added throughout the school year

HSE WRITING BOOT CAMP - June 3 - 26, Hamilton Ad. Ctr Room 9

- Open to all TAS students ; Prepares students to take the HSE Writing Exam.
- Practice your reading, speaking, listening, writing skills.
- Improve your academic writing skills.

HSE SOCIAL STUDIES BOOT CAMP - June 3 - 26, Hamilton Ad. Ctr Room 9

- Prepares students to take the HSE Social Studies Exam.
- Increase your knowledge of the four main social studies content areas: history, civics/government, economics, and geography.

HSE SCIENCE BOOT CAMP - June 3 - 26, Hamilton Ad. Ctr Room 9

- Prepares students to take the HSE Science Exam.
- Increase your knowledge of the three main science content areas: life science, physical science, and earth science.

HSE MATH BOOT CAMP - June 3 - 26, Hamilton Ad. Ctr Room 3

- Prepares students to take the HSE Math Exam.
- Pre-requisites - Math A, Math B, and preferably Algebra 1A or equivalent.
- Covers necessary math skills and knowledge to pass the HSE Math exam.
